MICHAEL BYRON, a graduate of theatre at Western Washington State College, appeared in their productions of A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM, LION IN WINTER, PETER PAN, CABARET and THE FANTASTICKS. He has also appeared with the Lyric Theatre, Highline High School and the Bellingham Festival Theatre in GIRL CRAZY, BRIGADOON, THE KING AND I, THE SOUND OF MUSIC and THE FANTASTICKS. This summer, he trained with the Utah Repertory Dance Theatre in Salt Lake and plans to do further professional training with the University of Utah in theatre and dance.

CHRISTOPHER DUNCAN choreographed ACT's musical production last year of YOUR OWN THING. Son of Tiny and Pat Calkins of Seattle, he left home at 17 to join the San Francisco Ballet Company on a Ford Grant Scholarship. An audition for Gower Champion led to Carol Channing's tour of HELLO, DOLLY in which he played Barnaby Tucker numerous times, including a Command Performance at Lyndon Johnson's White House East. In New York, he was in SWEET CHARITY, THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM IS NOT TRUSTWORTHY and YOUR OWN THING.

RANDY HERRON is a graduate of the University of Southern California in theatre and cinema. Stage credits in Los Angeles and New York include YOUR OWN THING, THE ENCHANTED, OKLAHOMA and THE FANTASTICKS. He has appeared on television in THE VIRGINIAN, ALFRED HITCHCOCK PRESENTS, WINDOW ON MAIN STREET and LEAVE IT TO BEAVER. He was also in the award-winning Roland Reed documentary on safe driving, THE LONGEST ROAD.

ALFRED MAZZA played the title role for 2½ years in the off-Broadway production of YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, CHARLIE BROWN. He was in the Paramount production of THE OUT-OF-TOWNERS with Sandy Dennis and Jack Lemmon, and has appeared on the DICK CAVETT SHOW. He studied at the American Academy of Dramatic Arts, New York.

LIZ O'NEAL hails from Chattanooga, Tennessee where she taught third grade before going to New York. She played Lucy in the Broadway revival of YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, CHARLIE BROWN this summer. She was in FLOWERS & TREES, an off-Broadway musical and has been in numerous productions at theatres up and down the East Coast, including appearances with the Chattanooga Opera Association and a children's theatre tour of YOUNG ABE LINCOLN. She received her vocal training at the Cadek Conservatory of Music and is a graduate of the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga.

SUSAN ROBERTS graduated from Stanford in music and drama, then studied acting, singing and dance for two years in London. Last season, she was with Playhouse Holiday, Vancouver, B.C., and entertained in Barkerville, a restored goldrush town. At the invitation of the Provincial Centennial Committee, the show BARKERVILLE '71 was formed, and the group toured 230 communities promoting the B. C. Centennial.

STAN KEEN, Broadway theatre veteran, is now in his third season as Music Consultant for ACT. He has served as Musical Director for ACT's productions of CELEBRATION and YOUR OWN THING, as well as contributing the original, incidental music and songs for THE CAUCASIAN CHALK CIRCLE, A CRY OF PLAYERS and AN ORIGINAL ABSURD MUSICAL REVUE FOR CHILDREN.

Director, GREGORY A. FALLS. He is ACT's Artistic Director and founder. This season, he directed THE NIGHT THOREAU SPENT IN JAIL. Last season, he directed YOUR OWN THING, THE BALCONY, THE CAUCASIAN CHALK CIRCLE and THE BIRTHDAY PARTY.
