"Butterflies Are Free" was first presented at the Booth Theatre, New York City, October 21, 1969. It ran for 1,128 performances and closed on July 2nd of this year. It has also enjoyed successful runs in London and most of Europe's major capitals.

JEAN BURCH has appeared in many productions at A Contemporary Theatre. Among them are A DELICATE BALANCE, TINY ALICE, A THURBER CARNIVAL, THE LION IN WINTER, CAT ON A HOT TIN ROOF, WHO'LL SAVE THE PLOWBOY?, DARK OF THE MOON, INADMISSABLE EVIDENCE, IN WHITE AMERICA, AFTER THE FALL, THE COLLECTION and RHINOCEROS. She has also played summer stock at the Boothbay Playhouse in Maine, the Stowe Playhouse in Vermont and the Champlain Shakespeare Festival, in a variety of roles.

WAYNE HUDGINS was in ACT'S MOONCHILDREN and THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE. He was also in our productions of YOUR OWN THING, ROSENCRANTZ & GUILDENSTERN ARE DEAD and "a children's theatre." Last year he appeared in HOTEL PARADISO at the Seattle Repertory Theatre, and his credits at the University of Washington include SCENES FROM AMERICAN LIFE, WOMEN AT THE TOMB, CHRONICLES OF HELL and ANTIGONE.

LEE SHALLAT was in this season's MOONCHILDREN and THE EFFECT OF GAMMA RAYS ON MAN-IN-THE-MOON MARIGOLDS at ACT. She has appeared at the Showboat in SCENES FROM AMERICAN LIFE, WOMEN AT THE TOMB, CHRONICLES OF HELL and ANTIGONE. She was also in Stage One's WAX MONKEY & OTHER TALES and THREE HOURS AFTER MARRIAGE. At the Milwaukee Repertory she was in PUSS 'N BOOTS. In 1967-68, she produced and presented six educational television programs on Asian Theatre for the Norwalk School District, Norwalk, Connecticut.

KELLY WALTERS was in ACT's MOONCHILDREN, WHAT THE BUTLER SAW and THE ME NOBODY KNOWS, this season. He has also been in our productions of MARAT/SADE and PHILADELPHIA HERE I COME! At the Seattle Repertory Theatre, he has appeared in INDIANS and A FLEA IN HER EAR. Last fall he toured with ACT's SECOND ABSURD MUSICAL REVUE FOR CHILDREN and with Seattle Opera's THE MAGICAL MARRIAGE.

CLAYTON CORZATTE, Director, is well known to Seattle audiences as a director and an actor. His last assignment at ACT was in 1970 when he directed THE PRIME OF MISS JEAN BRODIE. Prior to that, he directed SUMMERTREE for the Seattle Repertory Theatre and later at the University of Michigan. He also directed BUS STOP for the BFA Program at the University of Washington. A member of the School of Drama faculty, he teaches acting and has directed THE RIVALS, THE THREE SISTERS, EASTWARD HO! and SCENES FROM AMERICAN LIFE. Other credits at the Seattle Repertory include directing GETTING MARRIED and acting in RICHARD II, THE PRICE, ADAPTATION and A FLEA IN HER EAR. At the Milwaukee Repertory, earlier this summer, he played the Vagabond in THE TAVERN; he will also direct THE TAVERN for the Seattle Repertory Theatre this coming season. Last summer, he performed with Susan Ludlow in George Bernard Shaw's two-character entertainment, A VILLAGE WOOING, touring with it throughout the Puget Sound area under the auspices of the King County Arts Commission.
