WILLIAM NEWMAN, who has acted in 74 productions during eight seasons in repertory theatres across the U.S., was in ACT's production of THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE. At the Seattle Rep he was in THE CHERRY ORCHARD, TWELFTH NIGHT and THE VISIT. At Center Stage, Baltimore, he was in AN ENEMY OF THE PEOPLE and HAMLET and, at Stephens Playhouse in Columbia, Mo., in LUV, THE TIME OF YOUR LIFE and THREE PENNY OPERA. This year, he was in the off-Broadway production of BEGGAR'S OPERA.

LEE SHALLAT was in this season's THE EFFECT OF GAMMA RAYS ON MAN-IN-THE-MOON MARIGOLDS at ACT. At the Seattle Rep he has appeared in INDIANS and A FLEA IN HER EAR. Last fall he toured with ACT's SECOND ABSURD MUSICAL REVUE FOR CHILDREN and with Seattle Opera's THE MAGICAL MARRIAGE.

RUSSELL WOODBURY was last seen in RASHOMON at the Cirque Theatre. He was a member of The Actors Workshop in San Francisco and appeared in several plays with The Theatre Arts in San Francisco. He is currently Director of Stage Arts Theatre School in Seattle

PIRIE MacDONALD, Director recently directed A STREETCAR NAMED DESIRE for the Penn State Festival Theatre. Last season, he directed ACT's production of HADRIAN VII and in 1968, WAITING FOR GODOT. For several seasons he was Associate Director for the Seattle Repertory Theatre, where his productions included THE HOSTAGE, VOLPONE and A LONG DAY'S JOURNEY INTO NIGHT. He has also directed for the Trinity Square Repertory in Providence, The Actors Theatre of Louisville and the San Diego Shakespeare Festival. Last summer at the playwright's workshop of the Berkshire Theatre Festival one of his plays was THE RUNNER STUMBLES by Milan Stitt. It is now under option for Broadway this fall. In another field of endeavor, the MacDonald green pole beans recently won first prize at the Bridgewater (Conn.) Country Fair.
