Just before coming to Seattle, he appeared in MY FAIR LADY at Chateau de Ville, Boston. Other credits are the Buffalo Studio-Arena, Pittsburgh Playhouse and a featured role in the film BANANAS.

DON BEARDEN was in "a children's theatre" productions of THE STORY SPINNERS and COURAGEOUS KI AND THE SERPENT this summer. At the Seattle Rep, he has appeared in THE MISER and RICHARD II, as well as two productions for Seattle Junior Programs. His credits at the University of Washington include MACBETH, THE BEAUX' STRATEGEM and EASTWARD HO!

GLENN BUTTKUS was in ACT's A CRY OF PLAYERS last season. At the Seattle Rep, he was in RICHARD II and at the Lyric Theatre in THE DISPATCHER. Other credits include PEER GYNT, The Players Company production at the Aqua Theatre and ALICE IN WONDERLAND for Seattle Junior Programs. He has also been in CHRONICLES OF HELL, ROOMS, THE CAVERN, CALIGUA, BAAL and MACBETH at the U. of W.

SID CONRAD was in our recent production of THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE. He has appeared on both coasts in such plays as A LONG DAY'S JOURNEY INTO NIGHT, THE CONSTANT WIFE, THE DEVILS, HELOISE, CACTUS FLOWER and OTHELLO. TV credits include THE FBI and DAYS OF OUR LIVES. He recently received his Master's Degree in Arts Management from UCLA. He has also appeared off-Broadway, at The Center Theatre in Los Angeles and The American Theatre in Portland.

PATRICK G. DUFFY was in ACT's productions of YOUR OWN THING, THE BALCONY, ROSENCRANTZ & GUILDENSTERN ARE DEAD, THE CAUCASIAN CHALK CIRCLE and "a children's theatre." He has also appeared in INDIANS at the Seattle Rep and in Seattle Opera's PENELOPE. He has appeared in many plays at the University of Washington and just finished directing Highline School District's annual summer stock show

DEBORAH HEDWALL was in this summer's production of THIRTEEN CLOCKS at The Bathhouse Theatre. An original member of the Motley Mummies, she has also appeared in LITTLE MURDERS at Driftwood Playhouse in Edmonds and in Stage One productions of THE TEMPEST and FANDO & LIS.

WAYNE HUDGINS was in ACT's THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE. He was also in our productions of YOUR OWN THING, ROSENCRANTZ & GUILDENSTERN ARE DEAD and "a children's theatre." Last year he appeared in HOTEL PARADISO at the Seattle Rep, and his credits at the University of Washington include SCENES FROM AMERICAN LIFE, WOMEN AT THE TOMB, CHRONICLES OF HELL and ANTIGONE.

CHARLES LANYER was in our recent productions of THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE and WHAT THE BUTLER SAW. Last season he played "Will" in ACT's A CRY OF PLAYERS and was in "a children's theatre." Other credits are CHRONICLES OF HELL and SCENES FROM AMERICAN LIFE at the University of Washington, and a tour with Seattle Opera's THE MAGICAL MARRIAGE.

WILLIAM NEWMAN, who has acted in 74 productions during eight seasons in repertory theatres across the U.S., was in ACT's production of THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE. At the Seattle Rep he was in THE CHERRY ORCHARD, TWELFTH NIGHT and THE VISIT. At Center Stage, Baltimore, he was in AN ENEMY OF THE PEOPLE and HAMLET and, at Stephens Playhouse in Columbia, Mo., in LUV, THE TIME OF YOUR LIFE and THREE PENNY OPERA. This year, he was in the off-Broadway production of BEGGAR'S OPERA.

LEE SHALLAT was in this season's THE EFFECT OF GAMMA RAYS ON MAN-IN-THE-MOON MARIGOLDS at ACT. She has also appeared in SCENES FROM AMERICAN LIFE, WOMEN AT THE TOMB, CHRONICLES OF HELL and ANTIGONE at the Showboat, and in Stage One productions of WAX MONKEY & OTHER TALES and THREE HOURS AFTER MARRIAGE. At the Milwaukee Repertory she was in PUSS 'N BOOTS. In 1967-68, she produced six educational TV programs on Asian Theatre for the Norwalk School District in Connecticut

ADRIAN SPARKS was in ACT's THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE and, last season in A CRY OF PLAYERS and "a children's theatre." At the University of Washington he was in CHRONICLES OF HELL, A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM and ANTIGONE. He is currently arranging a 1973 theatre tour of an original show, for small towns in the U.S.

GARY THOMSEN was in THE CAUCASIAN CHALK CIRCLE at ACT and in THE AMERICAN DREAM at the University of Washington. This summer with the Snoqualmie Falls Forest Theatre, he was in THE RAINMAKER and YOU CAN'T TAKE IT WITH YOU.

BEN TONE was in ACT's premiere of ECHOES and in THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE. In ACT's 1967 season he was in THE DEPUTY, OUT AT SEA, THE FANTASTICKS and THE GREAT DIVIDE. He has been in many off-Broadway productions including THIEVES CARNIVAL, the first successful production in New York of Anouilh. He was in the Hallmark Hall of Fame TV production of ALICE IN WONDERLAND and has toured the Northwest in Rip Van Winkle.

KELLY WALTERS was in our productions of THE ME NOBODY KNOWS and WHAT THE BUTLER SAW, this season. He has also been in ACT's MARAT/SADE and PHILADELPHIA HERE I COME! At the Seattle Rep he has appeared in INDIANS and A FLEA IN HER EAR. Last fall he toured with ACT's SECOND ABSURD MUSICAL REVUE FOR CHILDREN and with Seattle Opera's THE MAGICAL MARRIAGE.

RUSSELL WOODBURY was last seen in RASHOMON at the Cirque Theatre. He was a member of The Actors Workshop in San Francisco and appeared in several plays with The Theatre Arts in San Francisco. He is currently Director of Stage Arts Theatre School in Seattle.

PIRIE MacDONALD, Director recently directed A STREETCAR NAMED DESIRE for the Penn State Festival Theatre. Last season, he directed ACT's production of HADRIAN VII and in 1968, WAITING FOR GODOT. For several seasons he was Associate Director for the Seattle Repertory Theatre, where his productions included THE HOSTAGE, VOLPONE and A LONG DAY'S JOURNEY INTO NIGHT. He has also directed for the Trinity Square Repertory in Providence, The Actors Theatre of Louisville and the San Diego Shakespeare Festival. Last summer at the playwright's workshop of the Berkshire Theatre Festival one of his plays was THE RUNNER STUMBLES by Milan Stitt. It is now under option for Broadway this fall. In another field of endeavor, the MacDonald green pole beans recently won first prize at the Bridgewater (Conn.) Country Fair.
