CLAYTON CORZATTE was in our recent production of A CONFLICT OF INTEREST. In this play, he is recreating the role of "Bri" which he did for the Seattle Repertory's Off Center production in 1969. Mr. Corzatte teaches in the Professional Actors Training Program at the University of Washington, for which he has also directed seven productions in the past four years. He directed THE PRIME OF MISS JEAN BRODIE and BUTTERFLIES ARE FREE for ACT; SUMMERTREE, MISALLIANCE, GETTING MARRIED and THE TAVERN for the Seattle Repertory Theatre. He has also played 12 roles at SRT, and guest starred in THE TAVERN at the Milwaukee Repertory Theatre. He and Susan Ludlow have done two Rep 'n Rap tours for the King County Arts Commission: G. B. Shaw's A VILLAGE WOOING and their own adaptation of THE DIARIES OF ADAM AND EVE by Mark Twain.

SUSAN LUDLOW was seen in CAMINO REAL, ALL OVER and THE TAVERN at the Seattle Repertory Theatre, last season. She also played PETER PAN at the Opera House. She and Clayton Corzatte have done two Rep 'n Rap tours for the King County Arts Commission; G. B. Shaw's A VILLAGE WOOING and their own adaptation of THE DIARIES OF ADAM AND EVE by Mark Twain. Miss Ludlow has appeared with the Shakespeare Festivals at Stratford, Antioch and San Diego, where she was seen in THE MERCHANT OF VENICE under Allen Fletcher's direction. She toured nationally with Douglass Watson and Margaret Phillips for the Stratford Festival. As a result of his special continuing education project at the University of Washington, Miss Ludlow is the subject of a paper by Hugh James Lurie, M.D., titled "The Actress As A Mental Health Teacher."

MELINDA McLEAN returns to Seattle to recreate the role of "Joe" which she did for the Seattle Repertory's Off Center production in 1969. Now a resident of New York City, Ms. McLean appeared in MACBETH and UBI ROI off-off Broadway and most recently played "Cecily" in THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING EARNEST at the Dundalk International Festival, Ireland. Her Seattle credits include THE THIRTEEN CLOCKS at the Bathhouse Theatre, the Seattle Repertory production of THE CRUCIBLE, and while attending the University of Washington she was in THE RIMERS OF ELDRICH and ALICE IN WONDERLAND.

EDA REISS MERIN was in ACT's productions of A CONFLICT OF INTEREST and THE CONTRACTOR. She has been in the Broadway productions of Ibsen's A DOLL'S HOUSE and HEDDA GABLER, with Claire Bloom. She was also in GOOD WOMAN OF SETZHUAN, A FAR COUNTRY and MAN IN THE GLASS BOOTH. With the New York Shakespeare Festival Theatre, she was in HUUI, HUUI. Regional credits include appearances with the Hartford Stage Company, Arena Stage, Washington, D.C., Cincinnati Playhouse In The Park and New Haven's Long Wharf Theatre. She created the role of Mrs. Sarti in Brecht's GALILEO, opposite Charles Laughton. On television, she has appeared on the Hallmark and Dupont Shows, CBS Workshop, Edge of Night and Guiding Light.

JOAN NORTON was in OLD TIMES and THE CONTRACTOR, this season at ACT. Born in England, she now lives on Mercer Island. Her theatrical training was with the Northhampton Repertory Theatre. In England she was a member of Richmond and Tonbridge Repertory Companies, and the Hansen Court Players. She was in VINTAGE WINE, a production of The Comedy Theatre of London and in IS YOUR HONEYMOON REALLY NECESSARY?, a production of Duke of York Theatre of London. For eight years she worked in community theatre and education! television in Wichita, Kansas. She also appeared with the Northern Arizona Summer Festival in Flagstaff. In Seattle, she has worked with the Bathhouse Theatre, Poncho Theatre, Center STage and KVI Radio Tower Playhouse.

IAN THOMSON was in ACT's recent production of THE CONTRACTOR. He toured with the National Shakespeare Company for two years, playing in OTHELLO, TWELFTH NIGHT and MURDER IN THE CATHEDRAL. Off-Broadway, he was in THE HOSTAGE and SALAD DAYS. In Canada, he was a member for two seasons at the Crest Theatre in Toronto, appeared with the Playhouse Theatre in Vancouver, the Mountain Playhouse in Montreal and has been on the CBC television productions of FOLIO, FESTIVAL and STARTIME. He toured with the national company of SLEUTH and appeared in the film, PASSAGES FROM FINNEGAN'S WAKE. He recently played in MACBETH at Actors Theatre, Louisville.

Director, TUNC YALMAN. Last season, Mr. Yalman directed THE TRIAL OF THE CATONSVILLE NINE at ACT. He was Artistic Director of the Milwaukee Repertory Theatre for five years. Since leaving Milwaukee two years ago, he has been living in New York. During this period, he directed his own adaptation of Goldoni's THE LIAR for the Cleveland Playhouse and served as Resident Director at the Eugene O'Neill Memorial Theatre Center last summer. This year, he directed Gorky's THE LOWER DEPTHS at the University of Washington and, in 1971, Ionesco's THE CHAIRS and THE BALD SOPRANO. This fall, he will direct a production of Jay Broad's A CONFLICT OF INTEREST in New York. Born in Istanbul, Mr. Yalman has been involved in nearly every phase of the theatre in Turkey, France and the United States, including directing the Broadway production of THE TRIAL OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He is a graduate of the Yale School of Drama and has taught at Carnegie-Mellon University. \*
