



She was most recently seen in *Holes* at Seattle Children's Theatre, *Project X* at the Empty Space, *Driving Miss Daisy* at the Village, *Glass Menagerie* and *How I Learned to Drive* at Intiman, and *Copenhagen* at the Seattle Repertory Theatre, where she was a company member for 9 seasons. A founding member of the American Repertory Theatre, she toured with them in the U.S., Europe and Israel, and in the International Chekhov Festival at the Moscow Art Theatre. Ms. Owen has also worked at the Arizona Theatre Co., Yale Rep., The Empty Space, La Jolla Playhouse, the Guthrie, Actors' Theatre of Louisville, the New York Shakespeare Festival, Rep. In the Seattle area he has worked with the Seattle Rep (*The Shaughraun*, *Inspecting Carol*, *The Caucasian Chalk Circle*, *Curse of the Starving Class*, and more), The Empty Space, Tacoma Actor's Guild, and the Seattle Children's Theatre. He has been seen at regional theatres nation-wide, including the Huntington Theatre in Boston, the Mark Taper Forum, Missouri Rep, Arizona Theatre Company, Milwaukee Rep, the Denver Center Theatre Company, South Coast Rep, Portland Center Stage, Alaska Rep, San Diego Rep, and the North Shore Music Theatre, as well as spending seven seasons with the Oregon Shakespeare Festival.



Michael Winters (Ronald) has appeared at the Seattle Repertory, Intiman, Book-It and in over twenty productions at ACT, including five plays by Steven Dietz and last season's *Dirty Blonde*. He has also performed at A.C.T. San Francisco, Denver Center Theatre Co., Arizona Theatre Co., San Jose Repertory and Mark Taper Forum, among others, and very briefly on Broadway in *Wrong Mountain*. He has worked extensively in TV, most recently on *Frasier*, *The Practice*, *NYPD Blue*, and *The Gilmore Girls*. He is a recipient of a Fox Fellowship.



R. Hamilton Wright (Geoffrey) just finished playing Bill opposite Jeff Steitzer in *Things Being What They Are* by Wendy MacLeod, directed by Kurt Beattie, at the Seattle Repertory Theatre. He was seen last year at ACT as The Limping Man in *Fuddy Meers* and as the original Sam in *Fully Committed*, both directed by Mr. Beattie. According to Mr. Wright, "Some of my favorite theatrical experiences have been the result of Alan Ayckbourn's writing and Jeff Steitzer's direction: *A Chorus of Disapproval*, *The Revenger's Comedies* and *Man of the Moment*, all at ACT Theatre. Production Team

Jeff Steitzer (Director) This is Jeff's 10th production of an Ayckbourn comedy, including four directed for ACT (*A Chorus Of Disapproval*, *The Revengers Comedies*, *Dreams From A Summer House* and *Communicating Doors*). In the past 25 years, Jeff has directed over 150 productions including American premieres by Alan Ayckbourn, David Edgar, Peter Barnes, George F. Walker and Ken Campbell, and world premieres by Barbara Field, Erik Brogger, Steven Dietz, Jon Klein and John Olive. His work has been seen at Chicago's Goodman Theatre, the Berkeley Repertory Theatre, Atlanta's Alliance Theatre, Actors' Theatre of Louisville, Milwaukee Repertory Theatre and Seattle Repertory Theatre. Recent credits include *Two Gentlemen of Verona* at San Jose Repertory, *Driving Miss Daisy* for Village Theatre of Issaquah, and *Dirty Blonde* for the Arizona Theatre Company. Jeff is also well known as an actor whose most recent credits include *Pantalone* in *Servant Of Two Masters* at the Intiman, *Dogberry* in *Much Ado About Nothing* at the Arizona Theatre Company, and Jack in *Things Being What They Are* at the Seattle Rep. Two seasons ago he had a recurring role in the CBS TV series *The Fugitive*. Currently he can be heard on a number of CD-ROM games including the award-winning *No One Lives Forever 2*, *Alien vs. Predator 2*, and the Microsoft Xbox game, *HALO*.

Don Yanik (Set Designer) is pleased to be a part of the design team for *Absurd Person Singular* which is his first design for ACT. Don's most recent design credits include the premiere of *Things Being What They Are*, and *A Delicate Balance* at the Seattle Repertory Theatre; *Joyful Noise* and *The Last Night of Ballyhoo* for Taproot Theatre; and completion of his work as the Restoration Designer for the home of C.S. Lewis in Oxford, England. Previous designs include a commissioned work for the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, *According to Coyote*, which was produced at the Moscow Theatre Directors' Festival, Milwaukee Repertory Theatre, and Berkeley Repertory Theatre. Don has designed for the Honolulu Theatre for Youth, Burt Reynolds Theatre, Arkansas Repertory Theatre and several theatres and universities in Indiana, Tennessee, Louisiana, and Florida. Locally, he has designed scenery for the Empty Space Theatre, Seattle Children's Theatre, Village Theatre and Civic Light Opera. He is a Fulbright Scholar and was a visiting Professor of Design at the National Institute for the Arts in Taipei, Taiwan. Don is a Professor of Theatre and serves as Department Chair at Seattle Pacific University.

Rose Pederson (Costume Designer) has designed many shows for ACT including *Polish Joke*, *Temporary Help*, *The Notebook of Trigorin*, *The Nina Variations*, *The Language of Flowers*, *Life During Wartime*, *Sunsets and Glories*, *Eleemosynary*, *Shadowlands* and *My Children! My Africa!* At Intiman Theatre she designed *Nickel and Dime*, *Ghosts*, *Electra* and *Intimate Exchanges*. For the Seattle Repertory Theatre she designed *Boy Gets Girl*, *Copenhagen*, *Jar the Floor*, *The Beauty Queen of Leenane*, *Private Eyes*, *The Heidi Chronicles*, *Oleanna* and *House of Blue Leaves*, among others. Most recently she created the costumes for *Mirabelle: A Breeze*, which was commissioned by the Seattle International Children's Festival. On Broadway she did costumes for Bill Irwin's *Largely New York*. Her work has also been seen at The Kennedy Center, The Mark Taper Forum, The Empty Space, The Berkeley Repertory Theatre, the Arizona Theatre Company, the Idaho Shakespeare Festival, Tacoma Actor's Guild, Portland Center Stage and the Cleveland Playhouse. She is resident designer at Seattle University.

Rick Paulsen (Lighting Designer) is delighted to be returning to ACT, where his lighting was first seen in *Angels Fall* in 1983. Since then, Rick has lit literally dozens of shows at ACT; some favorites being *Tales From Hollywood*, *The Jail Diary of Albee Sachs*, *Happenstance*, *The Nina Variations*, *Woman in Mind*, *A Walk in the Woods*, *Red Noses*, *Keely and Du*, *Handing Down the Names*, *The Odd Couple* and *Lonely Planet*. Rick's work has appeared all around Seattle and across the nation. Some recent work of note includes *Copenhagen*, *The Drawer Boy* and *The Origins of Happiness in Latin* in repertory at Arizona Theatre Company, *Dr. Jeckyll and Mr. Hyde* at the

Cleveland Playhouse, *Inspecting Carol* at the Seattle Rep, *The Lion*, *The Witch and The Wardrobe* at Seattle Children's Theatre. He is, most importantly, devoted to his wife Roberta and Paige, his eleven year-old daughter.

Dominic CodyKramers (Sound Designer) Nearly four years ago Dominic designed his first show at ACT – Alan Ayckbourn's *Communicating Doors* directed by Jeff Steitzer, stage managed by Jeff Hanson and produced on The Falls stage. He had such a great time and relished the talented folks he got to work with so much that he decided to stay! Since then he's sound designed a number of productions in all three of ACT's theatre spaces and continues to wrangle the audio technology behind-the-scenes as Master Sound Engineer. In addition to his ACT credits, Dominic has worked with the Seattle Repertory Theatre, the Flying Karamazov Brothers, Universal Studios Hollywood, Pasadena Playhouse, Oregon Cabaret Theatre, Pacific Conservatory for the Performing Arts, and Santa Clarita Repertory Theatre. Dominic holds an MFA from California Institute of the Arts and is a member of IATSE Local 15 and United Scenic Artists 829.

Jeffrey K. Hanson (Stage Manager) Jeffrey K. stage managed his first production at ACT, *Lloyd's Prayer*, in 1990. Now in his 14th season, he has stage managed over 35 ACT productions including last season's *Fully Committed*, *Mourning Becomes Electra*, *Yellowman*, *Fuddy Meers* and *A Christmas Carol*. In 2001, he managed *Grand Magic*, *Big Love*, *Dinner With Friends*, and *Waiting to be Invited*. Other highlights from past seasons at ACT include *A Skull in Connemara*, *Quills*, *Laughter on the 23rd Floor*, *The Gospel at Colonus*, *Halcyon Days*, *The Illusion*, and Alan Ayckbourn's *The Revengers' Comedies*. Outside of ACT, Jeffrey K. has stage managed at Seattle Repertory Theatre on such productions as *Metamorphoses* and *The Cider House Rules*, *Parts I and II*. Other regional credits include productions at Seattle Children's Theatre, Intiman Theatre, Arizona Theatre Company, and New Mexico Repertory Theatre.



About the Playwright

Alan Ayckbourn (Playwright) Artistic director of the Stephen Joseph Theatre in Scarborough, England, Alan Ayckbourn was born in London in 1939. He worked in the theatre as a stage manager, technician, artisan and actor until he met his mentor, Stephen Joseph, who encouraged him to write. He has since written more than 60 plays. Sir Alan wrote his first play, *The Square Cat*, in 1958 under the pseudonym Roland Allen. Over the past 40 years he has created numerous highly successful award winning plays, among them *House and Garden*, *The Norman Conquests*, *Bedroom Farce*, and *A Small Family Business*. Also an established director, he has directed the London premieres of his plays since 1978. He directed Arthur Miller's *A View from the Bridge* at the National Theatre for Sir Peter Hall, and his production of Herb Gardner's *Conversations With My Father*, featuring Judd Hirsch, played at London's Old Vic Theatre in 1995. In 1987 he was appointed a Commander of the British Empire and in 1997 became the first playwright to be knighted since Terence Rattigan in 1971.




The world's most frequently performed playwright save Shakespeare, Alan Ayckbourn has penned award-winning plays for more than 40 years. ACT Theatre has produced nine of them (this one twice). He is best known for his black comedies about human behavior and, whether naturalistic, stylized or farcical, the problem of loneliness is always at the heart of his work.

In the contemporary world, Ayckbourn observes a spiritual vacuum in modern society and says his greatest fear is "that people will become isolated from each other, cut off by technology". He clings to the belief that they will come back to the community of theatre in the new millennium. At ACT, we share Sir Alan's dream.

"Conversations" with Alan Ayckbourn

Marianne Owen (Marion Brewster-Wright): The challenge in Ayckbourn's plays is to rise to the occasion -- the truth of the story -- and to let the comedy take care of itself, because as actors we always want to push all those "comedy" buttons. Alas, I speak from experience -- I've received many citations from the Comedy Police!

- **AA:** In my own rehearsals I am somewhat of a joke in that I never allow us to dwell for a second on the subject of possible audience laughter... I have found that the more we disregard it the more readily the laughter flows. And if it doesn't, well, we have a very serious moment in its place.

Julie Briskman (Jane Hopcroft): His characters are so rich and so true, and you have to be careful to play them with great delicacy so they don't suffer under the weight of too much ACTING.

- **AA:** As performances [of Absurd Person Singular] went by, I was to learn a vital comic lesson. Namely that a single, truthful, serious event can become funny when set alongside a parallel series of equally serious, contrasting events. The secret of the comedy is that everyone... [is] behaving in a truthful, logical manner. All are unaware of the comedic possibilities of their plight. In order to appreciate it, they would need to be standing well back from it all, indeed to be where we, the audience are. More important, by taking their own situations totally seriously, they present us with a choice of whether to laugh or sympathize, recognize and relish or identify and anguish.

Liz McCarthy (Eva Jackson): One of the wonderful things about Ayckbourn for an actor is his dialogue. It rolls off the tongue, and it's easy to memorize because it's written the way people really speak to each other. In fact, the characters are so very real that I tend to take mine home with me, and when you're playing a depressive suicidal woman, that can be very difficult to deal with -- especially as a single parent!

- **AA:** A lot of women feel that I pick on them for some reason, [but] I'm very aware of their plight in society and I feel it is not an insignificant figure, in England certainly, that the number of female nervous/mental breakdowns is higher than the male one.

Marianne Owen (Marion Brewster-Wright): I love the roles Ayckbourn writes for women -- young, old, whatever! They're fabulous, and as varied in emotional and intellectual texture as any actor could hope for.

- **AA:** I think there is a male and female side within all of us. Mine are relatively balanced [and I] seem to have quite a lot to draw on because of this. Men [often] have problems writing about women because they don't see the similarities.

Julie Briskman (Jane Hopcroft): This is my first Ayckbourn play, and what's amazing to me is the fine line he walks between complete hilarity and utter devastation.

- **AA:** I like to find in my plays a mixture...there are moments in the play where you can look at the audience and half of them are laughing and half of them aren't, and some of them say, "I'm sorry, I find this too upsetting to laugh at," and other people say, "I found it upsetting but I still laughed." And I like both. It's a recognition mixture, and sometimes things are so close that you can no longer laugh.

Executive Staff



Kurt Beattie (Artistic Director) joined ACT in 2001 as associate artistic director and was appointed Artistic Director in April of 2003. His director credits at ACT include last season's *Fuddy Meers*, *Fully Committed* and *A Christmas Carol* as well as *Via Dolorosa* during ACT's 2000 Bullitt season. Elsewhere he has directed *Things Being What They Are* and *Art* at the Seattle Rep, productions at The Empty Space, Intiman, and the University of Washington. As an actor he has appeared in leading and major roles at ACT (most recently as *Ebenezer Scrooge* in *A Christmas Carol*), the Seattle Rep, Intiman, and The Empty Space, as well as many regional theatres throughout the country. This winter Kurt will play the title role in Seattle Shakespeare Company's production of *King Lear*. Also a playwright, he is currently working on a commission for the Seattle Children's Theatre.




Susan Trapnell (Managing Director) was appointed Managing Director, for the second time, in April of this year. She served in the same position from 1982-2000. In the intervening 3 years, Susan spent two years as Executive Director of the Seattle Arts Commission (now the Office of Arts & Cultural Affairs) and Managing Director of the Guthrie Theater in Minneapolis. She is delighted to be back in Seattle and back at ACT. Susan holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in French from the University of North Carolina, and has lived in Lyons, France, Guelma, Algeria and Vienna Austria. She moved to Seattle in 1976 to work with the Bill Evans Dance Company, first as Director of Education programs and then as Managing Director. She has served as President of the Washington State Arts Alliance, Vice Chair of the King County Arts Commission and on the Board of the Downtown Seattle Association. She is currently a member of the Advisory Board of Arts Space, the Board of Town Hall and is a Trustee of the Kreielsheimer Remainder Trust.



Vito Zingarelli (Producing Director) joined ACT as producing director in 1998. He trained in stage management and production management at the Guthrie Theatre in Minneapolis and became Seattle Repertory Theatre's first production manager from 1980-85, encompassing the Rep's building and move into the Bagley Wright Theatre in 1983. Subsequently, Vito served as producing director for the Washington State Pavilion at EXPO '86 in Vancouver, Canada, and then as production manager at the Berkeley Repertory Theatre. He returned to the Pacific Northwest most recently in 1995 after serving as director of production at the Stratford Shakespeare Festival in Ontario, Canada. Prior to his appointment to ACT, Vito served as executive director of the Whidbey Island Center for the Arts near his home on Whidbey Island in Puget Sound.
