



WELCOME TO ACT



Our second show of 2007, Stephen Temperley's captivating *Souvenir*, is a thematic cousin of David Wagoner's *First Class*, which you'll be seeing later this year. Each examines the experience of being an artist and the obsessive dedication to the pursuit of artistic excellence—but as you'll discover, their central characters are very differently equipped to achieve it!

It's the mixed blessing of great, timeless music that it is an equal opportunity inspirer, creating sublime aspirations in both the talented and the more musically challenged. In the latter category, no one stands taller than big-hearted, tin-eared diva Florence Foster Jenkins, whose exuberant assaults on the operatic repertoire charmed and flabbergasted New York audiences in the 1930s and 1940s. The wealthy daughter of a wealthy banker, she descended several times annually from her aerie atop the Ritz-Carlton hotel, her faithful accompanist Cosme McMoon in tow, to share her passionate joy in music with those aficionados lucky enough to hold a ticket. Serenely oblivious to her lack of phrasing and intonation, her negligible acquaintance with pitch and rhythm, she believed in her gift to entertain, and entertain she did on every front. She designed her own costumes, made sure that there were at least three wardrobe changes in every concert to delight the eye, and scattered rosebuds into the audience when occasion suggested it. (If an encore was demanded, she would thriftily send an assistant out front to recover the blossoms and perform the entire routine again.) She remains an indestructible, cock-eyed icon for anyone who has ever traveled through the rocky terrain between Reach and Grasp. Her unsinkable determination to do what made her happy, regardless of ability, reminds us of the special bliss we can find when we love something enough to stand up fearlessly and be really, really bad at it!



MARK ANDERS
(*Cosme McMoon*) is happy to return to ACT, where he last appeared in *The Woman in Black*. Other local work includes *Dirty Blonde*, *Old Wicked Songs* (ACT); *Noises Off!* (Seattle Rep); *The Mystery of Irma Vep* (Tacoma Actors Guild); *Gross Indecency, A Midsummer Night's Dream* (Intiman); *Hanging Lord Haw-Haw* (Empty Space); and two *Hardy Boys* adventures at Seattle Children's Theatre. He has performed in numerous productions of *2 Pianos 4 Hands*, including one locally at Seattle Rep. He co-created a new Noël Coward revue, *A Marvelous Party*, which has won a Chicago Jeff Award and a Los Angeles Critics Circle Award, and will be playing soon in Palm Beach, FL, and Kansas City, MO. Mark has also written plays and the book and lyrics for a musical.



PATTI COHENOUR
(*Florence Foster Jenkins*) played Signora Naccarelli and Margaret Johnson in Lincoln Center Theater's *The Light in*

the Piazza. She originated the Broadway roles of Mary Jane in *Big River*, Rosabud in *The Mystery of Edwin Drood* (New York and London), Christine in *The Phantom of the Opera* (also Canada), Mother Abbess in *The Sound of Music* revival, and the Nora understudy in *A Doll's Life*. Other roles include Mimi in *La Boheme*, Isabel and Mabel in *The Pirates of Penzance* (NY Shakespeare Festival); Magnolia in Hal Prince's *Showboat*, Adeline in *Sweet Adeline* (NYC Encores!); Eliza in *My Fair Lady* (Opera Pacific); and Katherine in *The Taming of the Shrew* (Syracuse Stage). Seattle appearances include Glinda in *The Wizard of Oz*, Rosabella in *The Most Happy Fella*, Abigail Adams in *1776*, Lili in *The Secret Garden* (5th Avenue); *The Light in the Piazza*, *Our Town*, *The Servant of Two Masters* (Intiman); and *Oh Coward!* (Seattle Rep). She was a guest soloist in the world premiere of Imant Kalnins' *Rock Symphony No. 4* with the Detroit and Leipaja Symphonies, and has

a solo recording entitled *To an Isle in the Water: The Words of William Butler Yeats*. She is a recipient of the Clarence Derwent and Theatre World Award, a Tony nomination, two Drama Desk nominations, and the University of New Mexico's Distinguished Alumni Award, where she serves as National Chair for the Robert Hartung Playwriting Endowment Program.

STEPHEN TEMPERLEY (*Playwright*) was born in London, and first came to the U.S. as a teenager. He acted in several plays for the Public Theater in New York before returning to London, where he performed on the West End, on TV and in repertory. Since returning to the U.S., he has worked extensively in regional theatres, on Broadway (the original company of *Crazy for You*), and off-Broadway (*Up Against It* at the Public). The first of his plays to be produced was *Beside the Seaside* at the Hudson Guild. His other plays include *Money/Mercy*, *Dance with Me*, *That Kind of Woman*, *In the Country of the Free* and *The Pilgrim Papers*. *Souvenir* debuted at the Berkshire Theatre Festival before playing on Broadway.

R. HAMILTON WRIGHT (*Director*) directed ACT's 2006 production of *A Christmas Carol*, as well as *Scapin* at the University of Washington. His play *Greensward*—originally workshopped in ACT's First Act new play program—has been performed in Seattle Rep's Hot Type Festival and at Circus Theatricals in Los Angeles. As an actor, Bob's most recent ACT credits include Ariel in *The Pillowman*, Ed Devery in *Born Yesterday*, and Kauffman in *Bach at Leipzig*. It has been 25 years since Bob first appeared on the ACT stage in Sam Shepard's *Buried Child*. Since then, some of his favorite ACT experiences include *Red Noses*, *End of the World*, *On the Razzle*, *Our Country's Good*, *A Chorus of Disapproval* and *The Jail Diary of Albie Sachs*. Other recent credits include *Richard III*, *Heartbreak House* (Intiman); and *The King Stag* (Seattle Rep).

EDIE WHITSETT (*Scenic Designer*) is making her ACT debut with *Souvenir*. Other theatrical credits include *Lucia di Lammermoor* (Seattle Opera); *The Pied Piper of Hamelin* (Tacoma Opera); *Hansel and Gretel* (Pacific Northwest Ballet School); *The*

Man of La Mancha, *West Side Story* (Village Theatre); *Arms and the Man* (Intiman); *A Year with Frog and Toad* and *Charlotte's Web* (Seattle Children's Theatre). Edie lives in Seattle with Dave, one dog, and one cat.

MARCIAX DIXCY JORY (*Costume Designer*) has designed *The Underpants*, *The Pillowman*, *The Night of the Iguana*, *Jumpers*, *Good Boys*, *Omnium-Gatherum*, *The Odd Couple* and *Grand Magic* at ACT. Other credits include *Holes* (Seattle Children's Theatre); *Inspecting Carol*, *Memory House* and *Fire on the Mountain* (Seattle Rep). Prior to moving to Seattle, she costumed over 80 productions at Actors Theatre of Louisville, including 30 for the Humana Festival. Other regional work includes designs for the Guthrie Theater, Long Wharf Theatre, Hartford Stage Company, Manhattan Theatre Club, Circle in the Square and the Opera Company of Boston. Marcia has taught costume design at Tufts University, University of Massachusetts, Smith College, Bennington College and Cornell University. She is the author of *The Ingenue in White*, a costume design book.

RICK PAULSEN (*Lighting Designer*) is delighted to be returning to ACT, where his lighting was first seen in *Angels Fall* in 1983. Since then, Rick has lit dozens of shows at ACT, some favorites being *A Number*, *Vincent in Brixton*, *Fiction*, *Tales from Hollywood*, *The Jail Diary of Albie Sachs*, *Happenstance*, *The Nina Variations*, *Woman in Mind*, *A Walk in the Woods*, *Red Noses*, *Keely and Du*, *Handing Down the Names*, *The Odd Couple* and *Lonely Planet*. Rick's work has appeared all around the Seattle area and across the nation. Some recent work of note includes *The Chosen* (Seattle Rep); *Honus and Me*, *Harriett's Halloween Candy*, *Addy's Story* (Seattle Children's Theatre); and *Lost and Foundling* (Childsplay and Geva). He is, most importantly, devoted to his wife Roberta and Paige, his 14-year-old daughter.


RON GEIER (*Sound Designer*) was the resident sound designer at Tacoma Actors Guild for seven seasons, where he composed music and completed sound designs for over seventy productions. He currently teaches sound design to the next generation of theatre professionals at Tacoma School of the Arts, an arts-based public high school, and is

a member of the sound department at Seattle Center, where he enjoys mixing shows for audiences of eight to eighteen thousand. He is excited to be working on his first original sound design at ACT.

D.J. GOMMELS (*Musical Director*) has stood at the musical helm of over 200 productions of some 90 musicals, operas, concerts and cabarets across the country and abroad, in a multifaceted career spanning three decades. As an actor, opera singer, pianist, composer and music director, his credits are myriad. Local credits include *Broadway Maladies*, *Ruthless! The Musical*, *Dirty Little Showtunes*, *Ham for the Holidays*, and *Lives Upon the Wicked Stage* (Seattle and San Francisco). As a composer, D.J. has scored the films *Through the Eyes of a Friend*, *The New American* and *The Right to Dream*. He's featured on the CD *Behind the Toolshed* with the band Kitten in Manville. Recently, D.J. co-wrote/starred in the wacky *Mental...for now* at the Crepe de Paris, and he just finished a stint with *Menopause the Musical*.

JR WELDEN (*Stage Manager*) has stage managed *The Underpants*, *Mitzi's Abortion*, *Miss Witherspoon* and *A Christmas Carol* at ACT. For the past ten seasons, he stage managed at Intiman on many productions, including *The Grapes of Wrath*, *The Mystery of Irma Vep*, *The Dying Gaul*, *The Servant of Two Masters*, *A Raisin in the Sun*, *The Chairs*, *Crumbs from the Table of Joy*, *The Last Night of Ballyhoo*, *Full Gallop*, and *The Mandrake Root* with Lynn Redgrave. At Seattle Rep, his credits include *Blue Door*, *The Chosen*, *Stop Kiss*, *Things Being What They Are*, *The Beard of Avon*, *Game of Love and Chance*, *Golden Child*, *Design for Living* and *Pygmalion*.



KURT BEATTIE
(*Artistic Director*) has been ACT's artistic director since 2003, where he has directed *The Underpants*, *Mitzi's Abortion*, *The Pillowman*, *Vincent in*

Brixton, Bach at Leipzig, *A Christmas Carol*, *Black Coffee*, *Alki*, *A Moon for the Misbegotten*, *Fuddy Meers* and *Fully Committed*, as well as *Via Dolorosa* during ACT's 2000 Bullitt

season. Elsewhere he has directed *Things Being What They Are*, *Art* and *True West* at Seattle Rep, as well as productions at Empty Space, Intiman, University of Washington, Milwaukee Rep and Alley Theatre. He has served as a dramaturg and director at Ojai New Play Festival, the New Works Festival at Mark Taper Forum, and South Coast Rep's Pacific Playwrights Festival. In 2007, he will direct three evenings of readings for Town Hall's *Short Stories Live* series.



JOLANNE STANTON

(*Managing Director*) was appointed Managing Director in 2007 and brings to ACT a passion for building active communities in

the arts, education and social arenas. As an ACT Trustee, Jolanne recently developed a strategic plan that will guide the theatre into the next decade. She was previously a found-

ing principal of eAdvancement.org, serving non-profit institutions in the areas of development, member relations, communications, operations and strategic planning. For Princeton University, she developed an award-winning online community for higher education. In addition, Jolanne has worked with *Business Week*, Scribners, Greater Good, the Japan-America Society and Campus Pipeline. She has been an active volunteer in the Seattle community, where she helped create arts and cultural programming for Lakeside School, Mercer Island schools, and Seattle Art Museum. Prior to arriving in Seattle in 1985, Jolanne was a marketing consultant in Singapore. She graduated cum laude from Princeton University in Art History with special emphasis in French, Theatre and Dance.
