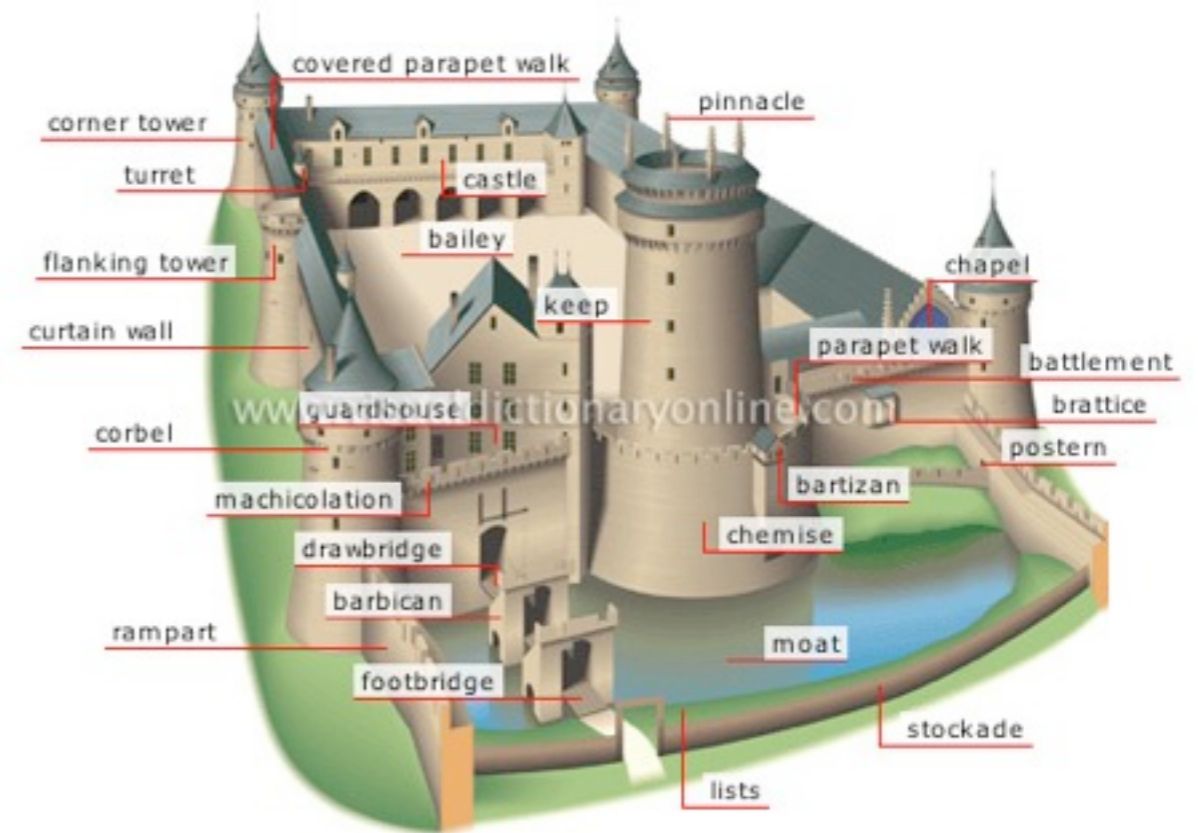
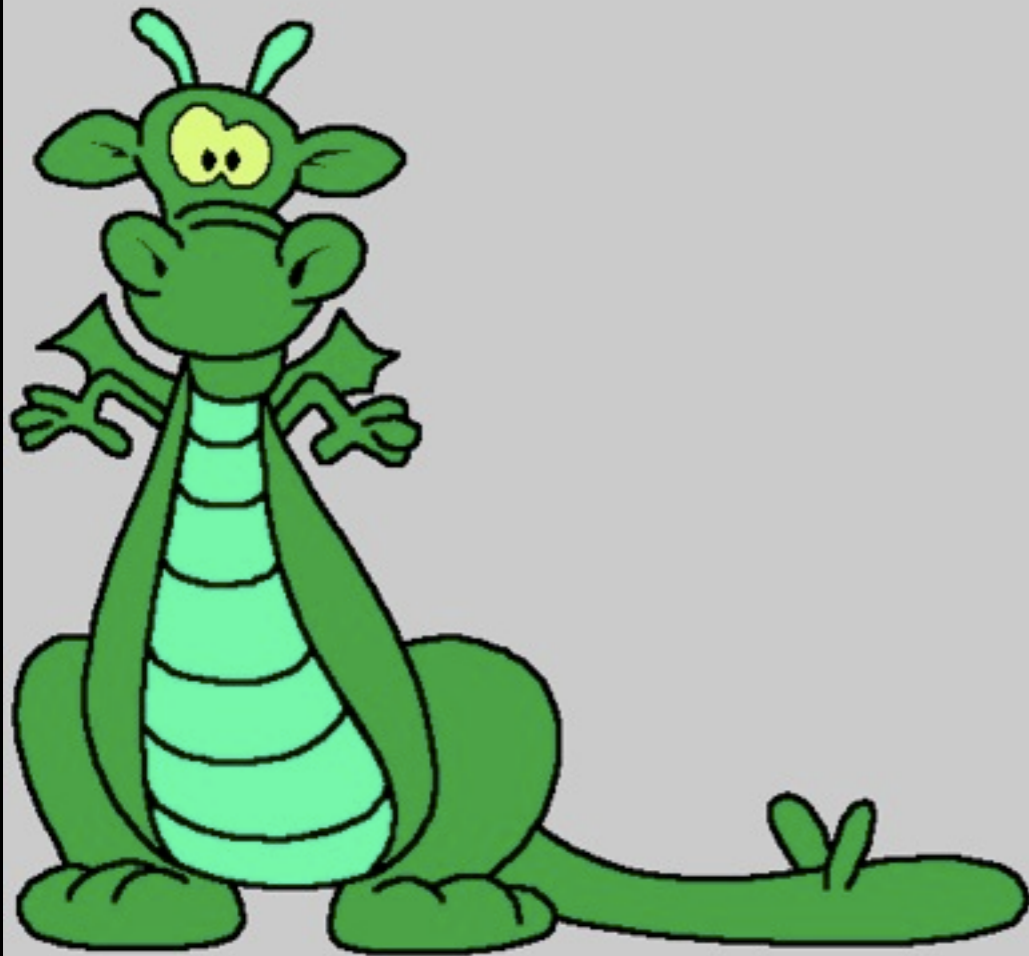

Get access to your clients clients

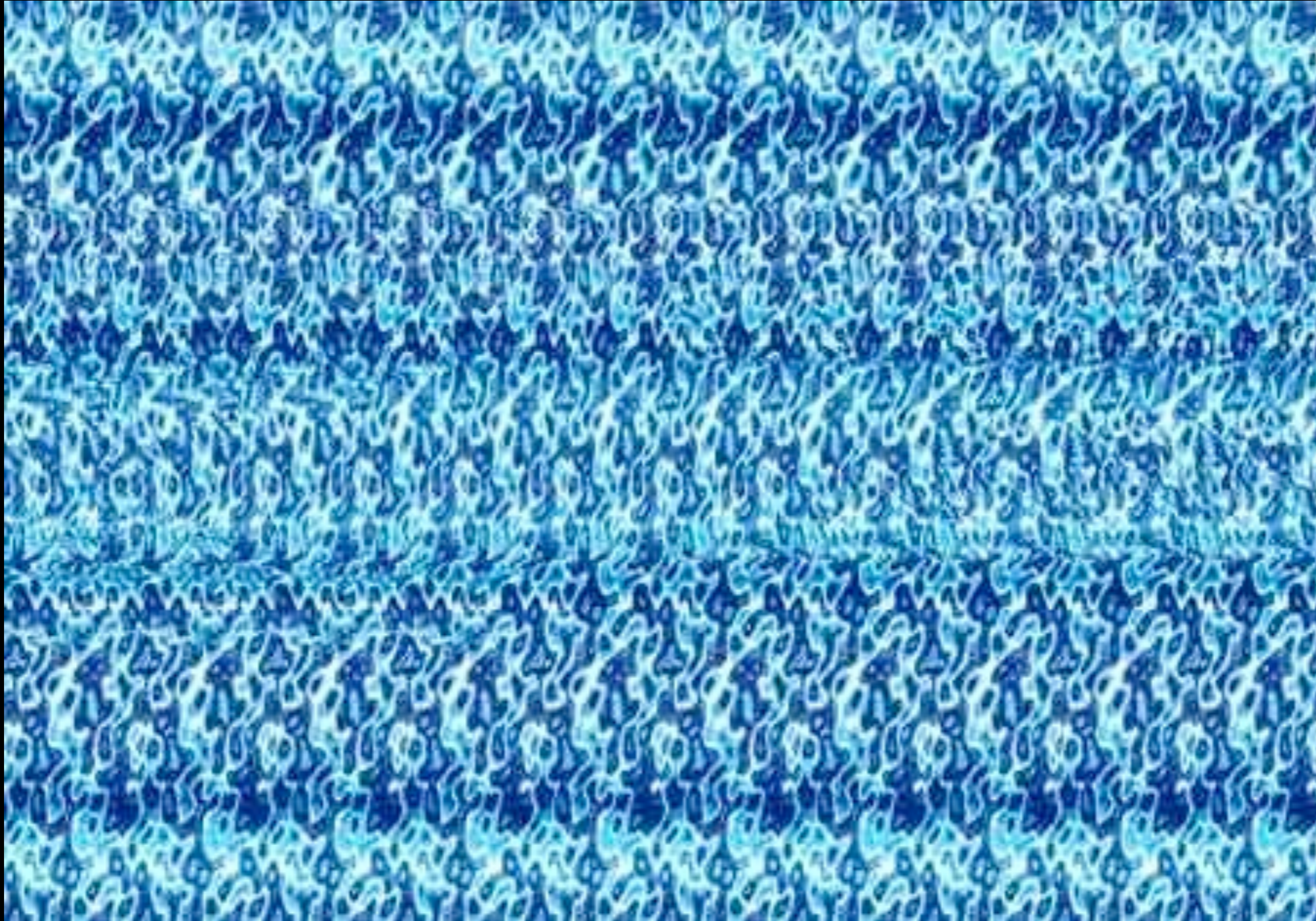
Allow ramp up time
