1. Call to Order

Chairman Peggy Crabtree called the meeting to order.

2. Public Comments

3. Reorganize the Board

Action:

4. Approval of minutes of the City Cemetery Board meeting of March 12, 2020

Action:

Ms. Connie McGuire moved to approve the minutes of the Cemetery Board meeting of March 12, 2020. Mr. Perry Giles seconded, All Ayes.

5. Discuss cemetery activities and take any necessary action

Mr. Gumaro Martinez, Director of Parks and Recreation, reported that in the month of October 2 plots were sold, 8 burials took place, and he noted that one family plot was sold.

Mr. Martinez proposed the Board approve a cemetery-wide clean-up in the upcoming year to remove excessive decorations that restrict maintenance to those plots.

Action:

Ms. Connie McGuire moved to plan a cemetery-wide clean-up for March 2021. Mr. Chad Hicks seconded, All Ayes.

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6. Discuss cemetery Capital Improvement Projects and take any necessary action

Mr. Martinez updated the Board on the progress of the cemetery pavilion construction, as well as the delivery date for the first columbarium. He noted the projected completion date had been moved from December to sometime in January.

Mr. Martinez presented pictures of the restroom to be installed as part of the future expansion of Addition 12. The Board discussed location and timeline of restroom.

7. Consider fees for sale of columbarium niches

Ms. Connie McGuire expressed the Board should put parameters on the wording and style of the niche-covers. Mr. Perry Giles mentioned a bronze plate would be too expensive and cause maintenance issues. Mr. Chad Hicks suggested it be mandatory upon purchase to engrave on the granite niche-covers. Mr. Giles replied frosting would look better since the granite is black, and the surface area is small. The Board expressed they would like to see some niche-designs and decide on a requirement for the sake of uniformity and aesthetic.

Ms. McGuire stated that at minimum, to recuperate the total cost of the project, the city would need to charge \$750 to \$900 per niche. She noted waiting until a design is chosen to decide a price point would be best.

There being no further business, Ms. Chelsea Holder moved the meeting adjourn at 9:26 a.m. Mr. Chad Hicks seconded, All Ayes.
