7. Ordinance No. 09-2021 Facial Covering Requirements Extended

Extending the Requirement for the Wearing of Facial Coverings.

Executive Summary: This Ordinance would extend the current requirements for facial coverings until a date certain unless earlier terminated, modified, or extended by City Council.

New Legislation to Be Introduced

8. Resolution No. 11-2021 EMS Billing Rates

Establishing Rates and Fees for Emergency Medical Transportation Services Provided by the City of Worthington.

Executive Summary: As authorized under Chapter 953.01 of the Codified Ordinances, upon recommendation by the City Manager, City Council may, by Resolution, establish fees for the provision of emergency medical services by the City. Emergency Medical Service (EMS) fees have not been adjusted since 2015.

Recommendation: Approve as Presented

9. Resolution No. 12-2021 Electric Aggregation Renewal Agreement

To Authorize the City Manager to Enter into an Agreement with AEP Energy, Inc. for the Provision of Competitive Retail Electric Aggregation Services and Electric Power Supply for Eligible Customers within the City of Worthington.

Executive Summary: The City's electric aggregation consultant, Energy Alliances, has solicited proposals from electric suppliers and is recommending the City continue for a two-year period with AEP Energy as its retail electric supplier and purchase and retire Green-e Energy certified Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) representing 100% of the energy supplied.
