City Manager Michael Scott gave the invocation. Council Member Melissa Olson led the Pledge of Allegiance and the Texas Pledge of Allegiance.

4. **Public Comments**

Chris Wright, 808 W. Marvin, Waxahachie, Texas, thanked Mayor Pro Tem Billie Wallace and City employee Steve Brigman for their quick response to a construction complaint in a residential neighborhood. Mr. Wright requested all supplemental appropriation requests be placed on the regular agenda instead of the consent agenda.

Alan Fox, 327 University, Waxahachie, Texas, asked City Council, Parks Department, and Cemetery Board to work together to remember the cemetery vandalism differently. He expressed his appreciation of how the community responded to the vandalism and their willingness to help.

6. Consider City of Waxahachie Annual Financial Report for year ended September 30, 2021

Ms. Paula Lowe, Patillo, Brown, & Hill, L.L.P., presented the City of Waxahachie Annual Financial Report for the year ended September 30, 2021. Ms. Lowe reviewed the Independent Auditor's Report noting it is their opinion the city financial statements present fairly in all material respects, the respective financial position of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, the aggregate discretely presented component unit, each major fund and the aggregate remaining fund information of the City of Waxahachie, Texas, as of September 30, 2021, and the respective changes in financial position and, where applicable, cash flows thereof for the year then ended in accordance with account principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Ms. Lowe reviewed the following financial highlights:

- All positive balances in all categories of Statement of Net Position
- Total Fund balance of \$47,208,244
- "Clean", unqualified opinion, which is the highest level that can be given

Ms. Lowe thanked Finance Director Chad Tustison, Assistant Finance Director Gail Turner, and their staff for their assistance during the audit process.

Mayor Barnes thanked the Finance Department for their hard work throughout the audit process.

Mayor Pro Tem Billie Wallace moved to accept the City of Waxahachie Annual Financial Report for year ended September 30, 2021 as presented. Council Member Melissa Olson seconded, All Ayes.

7. Discuss Solicitation Ordinance

Police Chief Wade Goolsby updated City Council on the process for permitting solicitors explaining the current ordinance requires a solicitor to obtain a permit from the Waxahachie Police Department. Applicants must provide their driver's license, fingerprints, application, and a criminal history check is conducted. Once all qualifications are met a picture id badge is issued to the applicant showing their name and expiration date for the permit. Permits are issued for 30 days at which time the applicant must reapply. Chief Goolsby noted 59 solicitor permits were issue in 2021 of which 62% were from out of state, 34% were from out of our city, and less than 1% resided in Waxahachie. He explained City Council can amend the ordinance to allow permits to extend

past 30 days but noted criminal history can change within a month and recommended monthly criminal background screenings to renew permits.

Council Member Travis Smith asked if the ordinance allows for enforcement and Chief Goolsby explained it is the discretion of the officer to write a citation or inform a solicitor they need a permit. Mr. Smith asked if the ordinance can provide an exemption for citizens and City Attorney Robert Brown explained there has to be equal application of the law and locals cannot be exempted. He explained the purpose of the ordinance is to screen solicitors and provide a layer of protection for the citizens.

Council Member Melissa Olson asked for clarification on the distributing handbills to residents and Mr. Brown explained the ordinance allows from an exemption for a permit in regards to distributing religious or election material; however, solicitors of any type must abide by the law and not trespass on a homeowner's property that has a No Soliciting or No Trespassing sign.

Chad Hengst, 119 Sumac Drive, spoke in support of monthly criminal background checks but suggested removing monthly fingerprints and allowing photo badges to be valid for 6 months. He also requested an online renewal process to streamline permitting.

Alan Fox, 327 University, Waxahachie, Texas, encouraged informing the public about the solicitation ordinance and asked how to control those solicitating without permits.

Kevin Ivey, 1980 E. Highland, Waxahachie, Texas, expressed his appreciation for the process and noted he does not support online renewals unless they are able to be fully verified by the police department.

Council Member Smith and Council Member Olson asked if there is a way to streamline the renewal process. Police Chief Goolsby explained he is not opposed to eliminating fingerprints during the renewal process as long as the applicant's identity can be verified and noted he would still like applicants to renew their permits in person with a criminal background check.

Mayor Barnes directed Police Chief Goolsby to prepare a recommendation on how to streamline the renewal process. Mr. Brown explained he will review ordinances from other cities.

8. Comments by Mayor, City Council, City Attorney and City Manager

City Manager Michael Scott thanked the Finance Department for their work on the audit.

Council Member Melissa Olson thanked the residents, City Council, and Police Chief Wade Goolsby for their open discussion on the solicitation ordinance. Council Member Olson requested to consider streaming the briefing sessions.

Council Member Travis Smith spoke in support of streaming the briefing sessions and requested to add the value of the supplemental appropriations to the agenda items. Council Member Smith thanked Gumaro Martinez, Executive Director Park & Leisure Services, and the Communications and Marketing Department for their work during the assessment of the City Cemetery vandalism.





Re: Approve Funding for Parking Garage and Farmers Market Improvements

Items Description: Consider funding the improvements for the city parking garage and the Farmers Market.

Item Summary: The city parking garage is now over 10 years old and in need of some upgrades and repairs. The parking garage is an asset for downtown businesses and provides parking availability for the many events held throughout the year. The recommended improvements include upgrading lighting to LED fixtures, a new camera surveillance system, refreshing and updating signage, restriping the parking spaces, and servicing of the A/C units in the IT and elevator room. The cost of the parking garage improvements is \$126,242.89.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends approving the \$126,242.89, plus a 10% contingency, for a total of **\$138,867.18** for the parking garage improvements.

Item Summary: The new location for the Farmers Markets has served the vendors and customers well. Last year's season was the best revenue producing season with total sales surpassing the \$250,000 mark. However, there are some much needed improvements that would help with the usability and accessibility to the new location. Staff recommends adding a thermal/moisture barrier to the roof and adding commercial grade ceiling fans to help manage the heat during the summer months. Staff also recommends adding a concrete, two-space handicap parking area with sidewalk connection to the entrances on the building. Additionally, an 8ft-wide sidewalk connection to the new Dog Park sidewalk would provide accessibility to the newly constructed parking lot and existing restrooms. The cost of the Farmers Market improvements is \$97,167.50.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends approving the \$97,167.50, plus a 10% contingency, for a total of **\$106,884.25** for the Farmers Market improvements.

Mayor and Council,

Our Vehicle Maintenance Account #54340 is down to less than \$8,000. Truck 3 is in the shop with numerous issues, the most important of which is the steering and suspension systems. The total estimate for these repairs is \$12,072.

Earlier this fiscal year, Truck 3 was involved in an accident for which insurance reimbursed the City \$21,259.61. likewise, Engine 2 was involved in an accident earlier this fiscal year for which insurance reimbursed the City \$3,292.50. Therefore, a total of \$24,552 was deposited into the City's General Fund from these two (2) accidents.

While we have been able to make other repairs without seeking additional funds, we can no longer do so. As such, I hereby respectfully request that a Budget Adjustment of \$24,552 be made to our Vehicle Maintenance Account #100-220-54340 from the City's General Fund.

Re: Consider Supplemental Appropriation of \$83,600 to Fund Additional Wags-A-Hachie Dog Park Improvements

Item Description: Consider approving a supplemental appropriation of \$83,600 from the Waxahachie Community Development Corporation (WCDC) unrestrictive reserve to fund additional improvements at the Wags-A-Hachie Dog Park. The improvements include additional irrigation, and adding Tex Turf 10 sod.

Item Summary: The WCDC was gracious enough to fund the renovations currently underway at the Wag-A-Hachie Dog Park. Those improvements included a new parking lot, new fencing, new shelters, and other amenities to name few. As the project comes to its final completion, there are some additional improvements staff feels would be complimentary and beneficial to the recent improvements made at the dog park. The following improvements are recommended by staff:

- Additional irrigation (interior dog park areas, and other common areas) -\$31,000
- Sodding interior dog park and common areas \$45,000

The total cost of the additional improvements is \$76,000. Staff would also request a contingency of 10%, or \$7,600, to account for any unforeseen expenses. Staff recommends a supplemental appropriation from the WCDC unrestricted reserve totaling \$83,600 for the additional improvements.

Please note that the WCDC Board approved the additional funding on March 18, 2022.

Fiscal Impact: The WCDC unrestricted reserve fund balance for the FY22 budget has sufficient capacity to fund the improvements.

PLANNING ANALYSIS

The applicant is proposing to construct a +700 sq. ft. (1,840 sq. ft.) accessory structure to the side and rear of a single family residential lot at 112 Homestead Lane. The Ellis County Appraisal District states that the primary structure on the property is 4,116 square feet. Per the City of Waxahachie Zoning Ordinance, an accessory structure that is equal to or greater than 700 square feet requires a Specific use Permit (SUP) to be approved by City Council.

Proposed Use:

The proposed accessory structure is comprised of 1,200 square feet of fully enclosed space and 640 square feet of partially covered patio space. The applicant is proposing to construct the structure out of exterior metal panels. The structure is intended to be used for the storage of vehicles and equipment, and serve as a workshop space. During site visits, staff noticed that there are other accessory structures in the surrounding area of a similar design and function. Larger comparable accessory structures (2,400 square feet & 3,100 square feet in size) were approved in the vicinity recently at 101 & 125 Homestead Lane respectively. However, the approved accessory structure at 125 Homestead Lane has yet to be constructed.

The applicant has confirmed to staff that the structure will not be used as a dwelling of any kind and will not be metered, sold, or leased separately from the existing home. The accessory structure will be connected to the exiting driveway with a concrete drive. At the time of this report (March 16, 2022), staff has yet to receive any correspondence from neighbors in the surrounding area regarding this SUP request, in support or opposition.

PUBLIC NOTIFICATIONS

To comply with State law contained in Local Government Code Chapter 211 and the City's public hearing notice requirements, 9 notices were mailed to property owners within 200 feet of the request. In addition, a notice was published in the Waxahachie Sun and a sign was visibly posted at the property.

RECOMMENDATION

Based on the details provided in this Staff Report and the present status of the documents subject to the request, the Planning and Zoning Department recommends:

- Denial
- Approval, as presented.
- Approval, per the following comments:
 - 1. The accessory structure shall not be used as a dwelling.
 - 2. The accessory structure shall not be used for commercial purposes.
 - 3. The accessory structure shall not be leased or sold separately from the primary residence and shall not be separately metered.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT (SUP) TO PERMIT AN ACCESSORY STRUCTURE EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN 700 SQUARE FEET USE WITHIN A PLANNED DEVELOPMENT-23-SINGLE FAMILY-1 (PD-23-SF-1) ZONING DISTRICT, LOCATED 112 HOMESTEAD LANE, BEING PROPERTY ID 269663, IN THE CITY OF WAXAHACHIE, ELLIS COUNTY, TEXAS, BEING LOT 4, BLOCK A IN THE HOMESTEAD ESTATES SUBDIVISION, AND ORDERING THE CHANGING OF THE ZONING MAP THEREOF IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAID CHANGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAXAHACHIE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Waxahachie having heretofore adopted a zoning ordinance and map showing the classification of the various property located within the city limits of said City; and

WHEREAS, the described property is classified in said ordinance and any amendments thereto as PD-23-SF-1; and

WHEREAS, a proper application for an SUP has been made in accordance with the zoning ordinances in the City of Waxahachie and said application has been assigned case number ZDC-19-2022. Said application having been referred to the Planning and Zoning (P&Z) Commission was recommended by the P&Z Commission for approval and the issuance thereof; and

WHEREAS, proper notification has been published for the time and in the manner as prescribed by the city ordinance of the City of Waxahachie for a public hearing thereon; and,

WHEREAS, a proper hearing was held as required by law and the Council having heard all arguments for and against said SUP;

NOW, THEREFORE, this property is rezoned from PD-23-SF-1 to PD-23-SF-1, with an SUP in order to permit an Accessory Structure Equal to or Greater Than 700 Square Feet use on the following property: Lot 4, Block A of the Homestead Estates subdivision, which is shown on Exhibit A, in accordance with the Site Layout Exhibit attached as Exhibit B, the Site Plan attached as Exhibit C, the Concept Elevations attached as Exhibit D, and the Staff Report attached as Exhibit E.

SPECIFIC USE PERMIT

Purpose and Intent

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide the appropriate restrictions and development controls that ensure this Specific Use Permit is compatible with the surrounding development and zoning and to also ensure that the development complies with the City's Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance.

Specific Use Permit

FOR OPERATION OF A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT FOR AN ACCESSORY STRUCTURE EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN 700 SQUARE FEET USE WITHIN A PLANNED DEVELOPMENT – 23 – SINGLE FAMILY – 1 (PD-23-SF-1) ZONING DISTRICT; the following standards and conditions are hereby established as part of this ordinance:

- 1. The site plan shall conform as approved by the City Council under case number ZDC-19-2022.
- 2. The development shall adhere to the City Council approved Exhibit A Location Exhibit, Exhibit B- Site Layout Exhibit, Exhibit C Site Plan, Exhibit D Concept Elevations, and Exhibit E Staff Report.
- 3. The accessory structure shall not be used as a dwelling.
- 4. The accessory structure shall not be used for commercial purposes.
- 5. The accessory structure shall not be leased or sold separately from the primary residence and shall not be separately metered.
- 6. The applicant shall obtain a permit from the City of Waxahachie Building Department prior to construction of the accessory structure.
- 7. The development shall maintain compliance with all Federal, State and Local regulations; including, but not necessarily limited to, all applicable standards and regulations of the City of Waxahachie Municipal Code and City of Waxahachie Zoning Ordinance.
- 8. If approved, City Council reserves the right to review the Specific Use Permit at any point in the future, if needed.

Compliance

- 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner, manager, or any person in charge of a business or other establishment to violate the conditions imposed by the City Council when a Specific Use Permit is granted, and the violation of those conditions could result in a citation being issued by the appropriate enforcement officers of the City of Waxahachie.
- 2. Furthermore, by this Ordinance, if the premises covered by this Specific Use Permit is vacated and/or ceases to operate for a period exceeding six months (6 months), a new Specific Use Permit shall be required to reestablish the use.

An emergency is declared to exist in that needed and approved improvements will be unnecessarily delayed if this ordinance is not effective upon passage and this ordinance is to be effective upon passage.

The zoning map of the City of Waxahachie is hereby authorized and directed to be demarked in accordance therewith.



ACTION SINCE INITIAL STAFF REPORT

At the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting, held on March 15, 2022, the Commission voted 5-0 to recommend approval of case number ZDC-17-2022, subject to staff comments.

APPLICANT REQUEST

The applicant is requesting a specific use permit to construct a 952 square foot accessory structure on the rear portion of the single-family lot. The subject property is a double frontage lot with the front facade of the primary structure facing West Main Street and the rear oriented towards Water Street.

The proposed SUP request will remain compatible with the Comprehensive Plan since the subject property is currently designated for low-density single-family uses in the Future Land Use Plan.

Thoroughfare Plan:

The subject property is a double frontage lot with access from West Main Street and Water Street.

PLANNING ANALYSIS

The Applicant is requesting a specific use permit to construct a +700 sq. ft. (952 square foot) accessory structure on the rear portion of the lot. The subject property is a double frontage lot with the front facade of the primary structure (approximately 7,727 square feet) facing West Main Street and the rear oriented toward Water Street. Per the City of Waxahachie Zoning Ordinance, an accessory structure equal to or greater than 700 square feet shall require a specific use permit approved by City Council.

Proposed Use

The accessory structure will have an enclosed space of 952 square feet and an open covered patio of 336 square feet. The Applicant has indicated to Staff that the accessory structure will not consist of a dwelling unit and will be used as a pool house for a pool that the property owner intends to construct in the future. Additionally, the Applicant has confirmed that the structure will not be metered, sold or leased separately

from the primary structure. Since the subject property is within the West End Historic District, the Applicant has indicated that the property owner will use similar exterior finishing materials used on the primary structure, consisting of a combination of siding and brick.

The specific use permit request does not approve any future expansion or addition to the primary structure other than the accessory structure. The future addition to the primary structure and the pool on the site plan were shown and provided for informational purposes only. City staff has received one letter of support for this request at the time of this report (March 9, 2022).

PUBLIC NOTIFICATIONS

To comply with State law contained in Local Government Code Chapter 211 and the City's public hearing notice requirements, 17 notices were mailed to property owners within 200 feet of the request. In addition, a notice was published in the Waxahachie Sun and a sign was visibly posted at the property.

RECOMMENDATION

Based on the details provided in this Staff Report and the present status of the documents subject to the request, the Planning and Zoning Department recommends:

- Denial
 - Approval, as presented.

Approval, per the following comments:

- 1. The accessory structure shall not be used as a dwelling.
- 2. The accessory structure shall not be used for commercial purposes.
- 3. The accessory structure shall not be leased or sold separately from the primary residence and shall not be separately metered.
- 4. The applicant shall obtain a permit from the City of Waxahachie Building Department prior to construction of the accessory structure.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAXAHACHIE, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Waxahachie having heretofore adopted a zoning ordinance and map showing the classification of the various property located within the city limits of said City; and

WHEREAS, the described property is classified in said ordinance and any amendments thereto as SF-1; and

WHEREAS, a proper application for an SUP has been made in accordance with the zoning ordinances in the City of Waxahachie and said application has been assigned case number ZDC-17-2022. Said application having been referred to the Planning and Zoning (P&Z) Commission was recommended by the P&Z Commission for approval and the issuance thereof; and

WHEREAS, proper notification has been published for the time and in the manner as prescribed by the city ordinance of the City of Waxahachie for a public hearing thereon; and,

WHEREAS, a proper hearing was held as required by law and the Council having heard all arguments for and against said SUP;

NOW, THEREFORE, this property is rezoned from SF-1 to SF-1, with an SUP in order to permit an Accessory Structure Equal to or Greater Than 700 Square Feet use on the following property: Block 321 in the Town Subdivision, which is shown on Exhibit A, in accordance with the Site Layout Exhibit attached as Exhibit B, the Concept Elevations attached as Exhibit C, and the Staff Report attached as Exhibit D.

SPECIFIC USE PERMIT

Purpose and Intent

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide the appropriate restrictions and development controls that ensure this Specific Use Permit is compatible with the surrounding development and zoning and to also ensure that the development complies with the City's Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance.

Specific Use Permit

FOR OPERATION OF A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT FOR AN ACCESSORY STRUCTURE EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN 700 SQUARE FEET USE WITHIN A SINGLE FAMILY – 1 (SF-1) ZONING DISTRICT; the following standards and conditions are hereby established as part of this ordinance:

- 1. The site plan shall conform as approved by the City Council under case number ZDC-17-2022.
- 2. The development shall adhere to the City Council approved Exhibit A Location Exhibit, Exhibit B- Site Layout Plan, Exhibit C Concept Elevations, and Exhibit D Staff Report.
- 3. The accessory structure shall not be used as a dwelling.
- 4. The accessory structure shall not be used for commercial purposes.
- 5. The accessory structure shall not be leased or sold separately from the primary residence and shall not be separately metered.
- 6. The applicant shall obtain a permit from the City of Waxahachie Building Department prior to construction of the accessory structure.
- 7. The development shall maintain compliance with all Federal, State and Local regulations; including, but not necessarily limited to, all applicable standards and regulations of the City of Waxahachie Municipal Code and City of Waxahachie Zoning Ordinance.
- 8. If approved, City Council reserves the right to review the Specific Use Permit at any point in the future, if needed.

Compliance

- 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner, manager, or any person in charge of a business or other establishment to violate the conditions imposed by the City Council when a Specific Use Permit is granted, and the violation of those conditions could result in a citation being issued by the appropriate enforcement officers of the City of Waxahachie.
- 2. Furthermore, by this Ordinance, if the premises covered by this Specific Use Permit is vacated and/or ceases to operate for a period exceeding six months (6 months), a new Specific Use Permit shall be required to reestablish the use.

An emergency is declared to exist in that needed and approved improvements will be unnecessarily delayed if this ordinance is not effective upon passage and this ordinance is to be effective upon passage.

The zoning map of the City of Waxahachie is hereby authorized and directed to be demarked in accordance therewith.





