4. Consider funding custom art commission by Desmond Mason for Hachie Heart in Freedman Memorial Park

Ms. Amy Borders, Director of Communications and Marketing, explained the second phase of the Hachie Hearts public art project is currently in development adding twelve new hearts in new locations across Waxahachie. The city has the opportunity to commission the services of Waxahachie native Desmond Mason. While well known for his successful NBA career, he is equally, if not even more renowned for his art. The request is for funding the painting of the heart that will be located in Freedman's Memorial Park in the amount of \$10,000, plus expenses (travel and supplies) not to exceed \$2,500. Additionally, Desmond and his family have generously offered to sponsor the heart that will be located in Lee Penn Park. With this, the City has the opportunity to have two hearts painted by an incredible artist who is excited to give back to his hometown.

Mr. Brad Yates asked if this request is in the parameters for TIRZ funding and City Manager Michael Scott explained TIRZ has supported beautification efforts. Mr. Yates inquired about the

annual financial TIRZ obligation and Mr. Scott noted it is about \$300,000 but could increase with the amphitheater.

Mr. Coy Sevier and Ms. Jane Vineyard expressed their thoughts on the benefits of supporting this request and the location of the Hachie Hearts on the east side of Waxahachie.

Mr. Mike Lee inquired about the current fund balance and Mr. Scott explained there is approximately half a million dollars available. Mr. Scott noted TIRZ jointly supports Community Beautification, three debt service accounts, annual downtown fire alarm programming, repaired downtown buildings and roofs, and is jointly contributing to the amphitheater.

Action:

Mr. Coy Sevier moved to approve funding custom art commission by Desmond Mason for Hachie Heart in Freedman Memorial Park, not to exceed \$12,500.00 and include modifications to contract. Mr. Brad Yates seconded, **All Ayes.**

As in past years, I have come to the TIRZ Board to request funding to add stars to the Downtown Walk of Fame. This year, I am requesting funding for two additional stars. If approved, the two new starts will be dedicated during the Crossroads of Texas Film and Music Festival, April 23-26, 2020. The will be located in the 100 block of S. College Street, near the Pocket Park.

The first part of the request is the pricing for the granite from Giles Monument, a total not to exceed \$3,200.00. The second part of the request is for \$2,750.00 for two stones, by On-Site Construction. These two entities have been used in previous years and have done an outstanding job.

The total request is for up to \$6,200.00 to allow for unforeseen overages, although none are expected.
