He indicated he would follow the guidelines with regards to that. There was more discussion. Glinda Felty made a motion to approve the sign for 114 S. Rogers with the above recommendations (use mortar joints for penetrations if possible; lighting must adhere to guideline requirements). Jeff Smith seconded the motion. All ayes.
