6. PRESENTATIONS:

6.1 Landscape proposal for artwork at Dr. Carreon Park for Commission Feedback: Sarable Ke was recommended by the Commission at a special meeting on October 22nd and approved by City Council to be installed at the Dr. Carreon Park on November 6, 2019. This approval included budget allotment for landscaping and lighting. Herman Design Group has been working with staff on the design and lighting concepts for the project and will present a draft concept for the space.

7. ACTION ITEMS:

7.1 Consideration of Funding Request for Desert X: Desert X has requested funding in the amount of \$35,000 from the Arts In Public Places Fund to continue their mission to advance high quality, contemporary public arts in the City of Indio and the Coachella Valley. They propose installing up to three temporary public art projects in the City of Indio. Each location and project is unique and intends to utilize and temporarily revitalize some of Indio's historic downtown locations. These projects have been developed to comply with state and city protocols for Covid-19.

Recommendation: City Council approval of the sponsorship of Desert X in the amount of \$35,000 of funding provided from the Public Art Fund.

8. STAFF ITEMS:

8.1 Update on the Deaccession of Elation: The artwork "Elation" located on median at Jackson Street and Indio Boulevard was damaged in 2018 and the integrity of the artwork has been compromised and cannot be repaired. Accordingly, City staff has schedule the deaccession process with Public Works and will update the commission on the specifics.
