Rules & Regulations

Grad Nite is organized and sponsored by Monte Vista parents and PTSA. It is a "safe and sober" FUN event that provides a substance-free night for the Senior Class to celebrate their graduation. Thank you for your cooperation!

- 1. Only MVHS 2020 graduates in good-standing may attend the Grad Nite event. Graduates must be pre-registered with all forms completed and be paid in full.
- 2. Graduates will check-in at their assigned bus at the MVHS "horseshoe" between 8:30 PM and 8:45 PM. Buses will depart promptly after check-in.
- 3. Graduates will be inspected by a professional security team prior to boarding the bus. If alcohol, drugs or illegal substances are found or detected, the graduate will not be allowed to board the bus and a parent/guardian will be notified immediately.
- 4. Only graduates who are transported by the designated buses will be allowed entrance to the event. *Additionally, graduates may NOT leave the event early.*
- 5. Graduates will return to MVHS around 3:30 AM to 3:45 AM. For safety reasons, a parent/guardian must pick up their graduate as they are not allowed to drive themselves home.
- 6. DO bring photo ID (required for check-in); cell phones are allowed.
- 7. DO dress casual and comfortably; bring a sweater/sweatshirt; wear closed-toed shoes.
- 8. DO NOT bring containers, drinks or food of any kind. Water and snacks will be provided on the bus.
- 9. DO NOT bring backpacks, bags, purses, wallets, keys or other personal items of any kind.
- 10. As with other school functions, the use, presence, or possession of alcoholic beverages or any drugs is not acceptable. Smoking or vaping is not permitted. Parents/guardians will be called and required to pick-up their graduate at the USS Hornet in Alameda if these rules are violated OR if their graduate becomes ill or behaves inappropriately.
